

GENERAL INFORMATION

The ESE Summer School has a long-standing tradition as an interactive hormone-, metabolism- and endocrine-related brainstorming event and meeting place between researchers in academia, industry and clinicians.

For 2018, the meeting venue had to be relocated to the small island Schwanenwerder located in the Wannsee, one of the major lakes of Berlin, because the traditional location of this summer school Monastery Mehrerau near Bregenz, Austria, is undergoing a major reconstruction.

The Evangelische Bildungsstätte auf Schwanenwerder can house up to 62 guests, participation will be confirmed on first come - first serve basis. An overflow hotel has been reserved in walking distance. Please note that the Summer School is being held during a busy summer season in Berlin – therefore alternative accommodations may be difficult to obtain.

Registration fee for students, postdocs and other participants is including entry to all sessions, welcome reception on Sunday afternoon, coffee breaks and the conference handout.

The room and full board package for the entire meeting is 440.00 EUR for senior scientists and 380.00 EUR for students and postdocs. The accommodation costs include 4 nights accommodation (arrival: July 15th, departure: July 19th). Additional nights have to be paid on your own and need to be confirmed by EndoScience.

Applications for travel/meeting grants need to be submitted directly to either ESE or DGE. To qualify for these grants, membership is required, which can be applied for in parallel with registration and which is affordable also for young investigators (e.g. ESE in training members pay 20€/a). Travel information

By air:

Arriving at Airport Tegel:

- Take the express bus X9 (direction S+U Zoologischer Garten) from the airport to S+U Zoologischer Garten
- Change to S7 (direction S Potsdam Hbf) to S Nikolassee

Arrival at Airport Schönefeld
