Dr. Ljiljana Marina works as an Associate Professor of Internal Medicine, at the National Centre for Infertility and Endocrinology of Gender (NCIEG), Clinic for Endocrinology, Diabetes and Metabolic Diseases, University Clinical Centre of Serbia. Her focus areas are in Adrenal and Reproductive Endocrinology.

Since 2014 Dr. Marina has been actively involved in the work of the European Society of Endocrinology (ESE) Young Endocrinologists and Scientists (EYES). As the committee member and for the last two years an EYES co-chair Dr. Marina served as the member of the European Society of Endocrinology Executive Committee. In 2022 she was awarded the ESE Special Recognition Award.

She is a member of the ESE Adrenal and Cardiovascular Endocrinology Focus Area's Expert Panel. Dr. Marina is also a member of the Serbian Medical Society, Serbian Society for Menopause, European Network for the Study of Adrenal Tumors (ENS@T), COST Action Harmonis@tion - WG 5 lead, and one of the founders of the Serbian Society for Adrenal Diseases and Cardiometabolic Endocrinology.

The NCIEG is a Serbian national reference centre for infertility couples, transgender patients, premature ovarian insufficiency, congenital adrenal hyperplasia, sexual dysfunction, reproductive endocrinology in general and adrenal diseases. The NCIEG also has a special Department for Cardiovascular Endocrinology, its own DXA scan and 23 inpatient bed capacities. Patients with obesity, osteoporosis and secondary hypertension are also referred to NCIEG. However, from a clinical point of view all endocrinological diseases are evaluated, from diagnosis to treatment and follow-up. The NCIEG closely collaborates (and share the same building) with the Clinic for Endocrine Surgery, University Clinical Centre of Serbia. This collaboration results in about 150 adrenal tumour surgeries per year.

With Prof. Svetlana Vujović, the NCIEG founder and head, this multidisciplinary centre represents one of a kind, state of the art endocrinology practice.

The research activity includes mostly clinical studies. The basic/translational research is performed in collaboration with Serbian basic science institutes or within the European projects. The clinical setting of the NCIEG allows the conduction of clinical trials, both prospective and retrospective.
